


There are a variety of ways to do this stitch, but I find this easiest for me. You will do this stitch after starting with the "Beginning Stitch".

Left handed	Description	Right handed
	1. Hold the yarn in the middle, ring, and pinkie fingers of your dominant hand, and the lucet in your non-dominant hand.	
	2. Place the yarn on the dominant horn above the yarn currently there.	
	3. Use your dominant thumb and index finger to grab the yarn currently on the dominant horn.	



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<del></del>	6. The stitch may naturally tighten because you are pulling on the working yarn.  If you need to tighten more, pull the yarn on the side of the dominant horn nearest to you.  The gauge (or width of the braid) should be specified in the pattern.  Try to tighten consistently every time.	<b>→</b>
	7. Repeat steps 2 – 6 until the braid is the length you need.
